WESTERN UNDERGRADUATE EXCHANGE PROGRAM (WUE)

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) is a program of the Western Interstate Commission of Higher Education (WICHE). Through WUE, students in the western states may enroll in many two-year and four-year college degree programs at a reduced tuition level: 150 percent of the institution's regular resident tuition. WUE tuition is considerably less than nonresident tuition.

The following states and territories	participate in the WUE	program along with Nevada:

- Alaska Arizona California Colorado • Hawai'i Idaho • Montana New Mexico North Dakota Oregon South Dakota Utah Washington • Commonwealth of Northern Marianas Islands • Guam • American Samoa

- Only NEWLY admitted students who are in a degree-seeking program are eligible to apply.
- The WUE application process must be completed before the student is in attendance at Nevada State.
- Applicants must be a high school graduate from an approved WUE state <u>OR</u> have maintained a legal bona fide
 resident status as a financially dependent/independent* person in an approved WUE state for at least 12 months
 prior to the first day of the term of attendance. *Students under the age of 24 on the first day of the term are
 required to provide student/parent/guardian tax returns to prove financial status.

 OPTION 1: OFFICIAL high school transcripts indicating the student's graduation from a high school in one of the WUE participating states. If transcripts have been submitted to NS admissions, please state so in email.

- OPTION 2: PART A: All students under the age of 24 on the first day of instruction must also include parent/guardian and student tax documentation to establish financial dependent/independent status. If the student if financially dependent, the following documentation needs to be from the parent/guardian.
- OPTION 2: PART B: Any TWO of the following supporting documents issued at least 12 months prior to the first day of instruction and indicates an address in a WUE state:
 - Driver's license or state identification card
 - Vehicle registration
 - Voter registration card
 - Federal/state income tax return
 - Proof of employment (W2s, pay statements)

- Payment of property taxes
- Utility statements
